Introduced to the market in September 2011, St. Arnold's Santo is a black Kölsch (which technically doesn't exist as a style, but that is how they describe it!) It is light bodied and floral yet with a distinct dark malt flavor that pairs perfectly with a plate of enchiladas. The distinctive label was designed by Houston-based artist Carlos Hernandez.
